




It's time for latkes! Can you help this dinosaur find his way to the dinner table?





MAKE YOUR OWN DREIDEL

Celebrate Chanukah (and your favorite dinosaurs!) by making your own dreidel.



You Will Need:


- Scissors
- Tape or glue
- Crayons
- A straw or pencil
- Game pieces (chocolate coins, pennies, or other small tokens)

What To Do:

- Color in the dreidel and cut out the template along the solid lines.
- For a sturdier dreidel, glue the template to a thin piece of cardboard (e.g., a cereal box) before cutting it out.
- Fold in the tabs and glue the dreidel together.
- Poke a hole at the x and thread a pencil or straw through the top.

How to Play:

- Distribute the game pieces evenly. (Each player should have about ten pieces.)
- At the beginning of each round, have everyone place one game piece in the pot.
- Take turns spinning the dreidel.
- When it stops spinning, look at the top image to determine what action to perform next.
- The player with the biggest pot wins!
